Native Houstonian Emily Hung, MD, earned her undergraduate degree from Princeton University and her medical degree from Baylor College of Medicine. She completed her internal medicine residency at the University of Pennsylvania, where she was awarded the H. Ralph Schumacher Jr. Award for Excellence in Rheumatology, and the C. William Hanson II Prize, given to the graduating resident with the highest overall performance in outpatient care.

Dr. Hung completed specialty training in rheumatology at The University of Texas Medical School at Houston, where she was elected chief fellow.
